

## Travel Guide Wellington and Winelands

#### Monday

Wellington Bainskloofpass Rock pools



Visit Bainskloofpass in Wellington. Stop at one of the view points to enjoy the beautiful view of the valley. Keep driving to the almost highest point of Bainskloofpass and park your car at the parking area on the righthand side.

(Witterivier Parking 1: -33.62323,19.09738/

Rockpool 1: -33.63168,19.10685)

Walk along the dirt road for about 15-20 minutes. After that you will see a path on the left hand side downhill. Follow the noise of the purling water and you will find the best place ever- the cool Roockpools. Take a dip in the fresh water, enjoy the breathtaking landscape and a little picknick.

Tip: enough water, little picknick, towel, hut, sunscreen, book and swimsuit)

#### Tuesday

Paarl Spice Route Biergarten

Start your day with a dilicious breakfast at Fairview. They bake freshly for you and had their own cheese.

Subsequently visit the Alpaca Loom Farm. Marvel at the beautiful animals, send your children to the playground and to the petting zoo or buy perhaps





a nice scarf made of alpaca wool. Of course from their own production. Now you have enough time for a beer tasting (CBC Brewery) at a german brewmaster, a chocolate tasting or a visit in the glass blowing. A sundowner in the beergarden "Grapperia" with a fantastic view (sometimes till to the Tabele Mountain) completes the day. Enjoy!!!

Paarl Cheetah Farm Ashia Wine tasting

Make an appointment at the Ashia Cheetah Farm. There you will get to konw the gepards up close.
